**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Josh Ruot presented the Treasurer Report. As of October 19 2011 the expenditures were \$2,675.67, revenue received was \$17,112.77. The General Fund ending balance was \$14,437.10

**ICC REPORT:** No Report

**ICCA REPORT:** Jeff Stehman reported that ICCA is still working with the Fire Officials regarding certification requirements. IEMA post disaster inspection program is in the works. The steering committee, consisting of IEMA, OSFM, Architects, Engineers, and Building Officials met in September 2011. The official committee will be formed in 2012. The State has officially adopted NFPA 101-2000 Life Safety Code. The new State Fire Marshall wants to adopt the NFPA 101-2012 code, which requires certain classifications of existing buildings to be sprinklered. Life Safety 101- 2012 will

supersede all other codes and there is much opposition throughout the state on the code adoption. More information to follow at future meetings.

- CEOSI/ ICC Scholarship recipients Erick Harris and Sharon Walter gave reports on the ICC Annual Business meeting in Phoenix AZ.
